- ◆ Up-to-date research on Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder in the way of articles on-line, accessible from your home computer.

- ◆ Videos on ADHD can be shown at an ADHD Support Group or they can be shown in our office.
- ◆ Emails forwarded to inform you of upcoming ADHD events from around the world.
- ◆ Support groups for ADHD: Parents of Children, Parents of Teens, Adults and Students.
- ◆ Informal meetings discussing ADHD a couple of times/year.
